STATEMENT OF FAITH

We believe:

1. that the Bible is divinely inspired. By this we mean a miraculous guidance of the Holy Spirit in its original writings, extending to all parts of Scripture, even to the choice of the words, so that the result is the very Word of God, the only infallible rule of faith and practice. Moreover, it is our conviction that God has exercised singular care and providence through the ages in preserving His written Word, so that the Scriptures as we have them now contain all things essential for salvation and godly living.
2. that God is one, and that He exists in three persons: the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit; that the Lord Jesus Christ is divine and that the Holy Spirit is a Divine person, with a personality as distinct as that of the Father or the Son.
3. that as through one man, Adam, sin entered the world and death through sin, so death spread to all mankind in that all sinned.
4. that the death of Jesus Christ was a true substitute for each individual, that His death was a sufficient sacrifice for the sin of all mankind, and that He was raised bodily from the dead.
5. that those who accept Jesus Christ by faith receive new life from God.
6. that individuals are justified by faith alone and are counted as righteous before God solely by the merit of Jesus Christ imputed to them.
7. that the saved will enjoy everlasting, conscious blessedness, and that the lost will suffer everlasting, conscious punishment.
8. that the return of our Lord is personal and imminent.
9. that it is the supreme responsibility of the disciples of the Lord Jesus Christ to make His gospel known to all people, throughout the whole world.
